

Albert Edwin Haim

Private, 7th Battalion, The Queen's (Royal West Surrey Regiment) (No. G/21780); previously Dorsetshire Regiment (No. 18204)

Born about August 1881 in Blandford

Son of Ephraim (a groom) and Matilda Haim

Married Alice Pitman in Blandford in 1905

Father of one son and one daughter

Lived in North Street, Stourpaine

Worked as a butcher

Killed in action during the attack on Desire Trench on the Somme on 18th November 1916, aged 35

With no known grave, he is commemorated on the Thiepval Memorial, Somme
