

Albert Victor Hiscock

Rifleman, 4th Battalion, Rifle Brigade (The Prince Consort's Own) (No. 2475)

Born about July 1887 in Blandford

Son of George Stephen (a glover) and Sarah Ann Hiscock of 22 East Street, Blandford

Worked as a labourer

Enlisted in 1907; posted to France December 1914

Killed in action at Ypres on 4th May 1915, aged 27

With no known grave, he is commemorated on the Menin Gate Memorial, Ypres
