

Alfred Douglas Cherry

Captain, Dorsetshire Regiment, attached to Somerset Light Infantry; previously London Regiment (No. 1734)

Born about August 1890 in Blandford

Son of Alfred (a draper) and Florence Cherry of Milldown House, Blandford

Lived in Fulham in 1911

Worked as a clerk for the Education Board

Posted to France May 1916

Killed in action on 4th April 1917, aged 26

Buried in Wanacourt British Cemetery, Nord-Pas-de-Calais

(His younger brother, Kenneth, was killed in 1915)
