Private, 6th Battalion, Queen's Own (Royal West Kent Regiment) (No. G/31426); previously Royal Sussex Regiment (No. 3201)

Born on 4th May 1891 in Wimborne

Son of Walter (a postman) and Annie Elizabeth Riggs of Queen's Street, Blandford

Lived in Brighton

Worked as a carpenter

Killed in action during the Battle of Epehy on 21st September 1918, aged 27

Buried in Epehy Wood Farm Cemetery, Somme
