

Charles Carter, DSM

*Leading Signaller, Royal Navy, aboard HM
Submarine K4 (No. 236423)*

Born on 18th January 1890 in Manchester

*Elders son of Thomas (a bootmaker, who died in 1918)
and Edith Carter of The Cabin, Kings Road, Blandford*

Awarded the Distinguished Service Medal

*Killed when HM Submarine K4 was in collision with
two other submarines in the North Sea on 31st January
1918, aged 28*

*His body was not recovered for burial and he is
commemorated on the Plymouth Naval Memorial*
