

Edward John Woodhouse

Lieutenant, Indian Army Reserve of Officers, attached to
38th King George's Own Central Indian Horse

Born on 11th November 1884 in Hilton

Son of George Edward (a brewer) and Alice Margaret
(who died in 1889) Woodhouse; George re-married to
Susan Henrietta S. Fisher in 1892; they lived at Nordon,
Pimperne

Lived at Sabour Bihar, India

Worked as an economic botanist to the Government of
Bihar-Orissa and was Principal of Sabour Agricultural
College

Died of wounds on 11th December 1917, aged 33

Buried in Tincourt New British Cemetery, Somme
