

# George Baverstock

Private, 2nd Battalion, Royal Warwickshire Regiment  
(No. 268824)

Born about February 1891 in Blandford

Son of Charles (a house painter) and Annie Baverstock  
of 1 Victoria Road, Blandford

Married Kathleen Louise Durant in Southampton  
about May 1915

Father of one son, born about February 1916

Lived at 48 Earl's Road, Southampton

Worked as a butcher

Enlisted December 1915; mobilised April 1917; posted to  
France on 12th August 1917

Killed in action at Passchendaele on 9th October 1917,  
aged 28

With no known grave, he is commemorated on the Tyne-  
Cot Memorial, West-Vlaanderen

(His younger brother, Reginald, was killed in 1918)
