

George David Hunt

Private, Tank Corps (No. 200086); previously Machine-Gun Corps (No. 2850)

Born about May 1891 in Blandford

Son of George (a baker, who died in 1907) and Sarah Ann (who died in 1896) Hunt of 20 Orchard Street, Blandford

Worked as a baker

Killed in action at the First Battle of Cambrai on 20th November 1917, aged 26

With no known grave, he is commemorated on the Cambrai Memorial, Louverval, Nord-Pas-de-Calais

(His elder brother, Ernest, was killed in August 1917)
