

George Lewis Gould

Corporal, 2/4th Battalion, Dorsetshire Regiment (No. 2994)

Born about November 1883 in Bournemouth

Son of George Edward (a coal merchant) and Annie Adelaide Gould of Oakfield Street, Blandford

Married Eliza Matilda Annie Lewis in Blandford in 1912

Father of one child

Lived at Fairfield Road, Blandford

Worked as an engineer

Enlisted September 1914; promoted to Corporal January 1915; served in India and Mesopotamia

Died of dysentery aboard Hospital Ship 'Egypt' on 16th September 1916, aged 32

Possibly buried at sea; commemorated on the Basra Memorial, Iraq
