

Reginald William Baverstock

*Private, 8th (King's Royal Irish) Hussars, Household
Cavalry (No. 27236)*

Born about November 1895 in Blandford

*Son of Charles (a house painter) and Annie Baverstock
of 1 Victoria Road, Blandford*

Worked as a butcher

*Killed in action on the Somme on 31st March 1918, aged
22*

*With no known grave, he is commemorated on the
Pozières Memorial, Somme*

(His elder brother, George, was killed in 1917)
