

Robert James Snelling, MM

Sergeant, 124th Battery, Royal Field Artillery (No. 53356)

Born about August 1882 in Swanage

Son of James George (a gasworks stoker, who died in 1917) and Mary Snelling of 13 Charles Street, Blandford

Awarded the Military Medal

Killed in action on 4th June 1917, aged 34

Buried in Aubigny Communal Cemetery Extension, Pas-de-Calais

(His younger brother, William, was killed in 1916)
