

Walter Clark

Private, 1st Battalion, Dorsetshire Regiment (No. 8741)

Born about September 1892 in Blandford

Son of George (a railway labourer) and Elizabeth Clark
of Mount Pleasant, 1 East Street, Blandford

Worked as a labourer

Enlisted in July 1909; served in Ireland

Killed in action on 24th August 1914, probably aged 21

With no known grave, he is commemorated on the La
Ferté-sous-Jouarre Memorial, Seine-et-Marne

(His elder brother, William, was killed in 1918)
