


Visualisation of the Heritage Meeting Place & Canopy

Artist Tim Ward proposal for the green space off Shaftesbury Lane at Badbury Heights is a communal meeting place with heritage seating covered by a high tensile canopy with hard surfacing and access path.

The two large heritage benches will each have seating on both sides with a central 'wave' feature with laser cut inserts depicting scenes from Blandford Forum's history. Constructed in steel with protective powder coating with text etched into stainless steel marine grade 316.

The interpretation artwork to represent the theme of 'Community Spirit' bringing together & enhance society, inform and unifying communities.

The hard surface 'square' to be fully accessible via an access path linking to other existing paths and be DDA compliant. This special meeting place creates a space for the functional artwork to be a centre point for public events, fetes or communal gatherings.

The high tensile canopy to cover the seating and be constructed in steel with protective coatings and a strong, durable PTFE Coated Glass Cloth is completely chemically inert and resistant to moisture and micro-organisms as well being good self-cleaning. The canopy to provide protection from rain showers and sunshine.
