Acts of Remembrance in Blandford Forum

Remembrance is not cancelled but we are having to plan events differently this year, to ensure we do so safely, and we are encouraging people to *Remember at Home*.

Sunday 1st November

The Royal British Legion Memorial Service at the Commonwealth War Graves Commission section of Blandford Cemetery in Salisbury Road will take place, but with a significantly reduced attendance. Photos of the event will be published afterwards.

Friday 6th November

Local schools will be laying crosses in the Field of Remembrance within the churchyard of St Peter and St Paul. However, this year, there will not be a civic service to mark this event and schools will be laying their crosses at separate times to avoid creating a gathering.

Remembrance Sunday - 8th November

The Town Council has been reviewing how the town can mark this significant day safely, whilst adhering to current guidance and legislation. At the time of writing, this is a reduced outdoor service in the afternoon, to be shared on social media. There will not be a parade, troops, brass band or a church service and we will be keeping numbers to a minimum and, sadly, not encouraging public attendance. Please check our website, notice boards and social media closer to the time for full details but we urge members of the public to observe Remembrance in a personal and private manner this year.



Armistice Day - Wednesday 11th November at 10.45am

Armistice Day is the day which marks the end of the First World War when the guns fell silent. The Mayor of Blandford Forum, Cllr Lindsay will be joining the national two minute silence in the Market Place at the eleventh hour on the eleventh day of the eleventh month. Wherever you are at 11am, please take two minutes to reflect and remember.


