## Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II 21<sup>st</sup> April 1926 — 8<sup>th</sup> September 2022

Following the demise of HM Queen Elizabeth II, residents and visitors to Blandford Forum filled three Books of Condolence, with a total of 735 signatures. As Books are not received by Royal Households, they were intended to be archived in the Dorset History Centre in Dorchester. However, due to the historic significance of HM The Queen's passing, the Town Museum has agreed to exhibit and store the Books along with a record of the Reading of the Proclamation, the civic church service and the national one-minute silence. As with the Queen's Platinum Jubilee celebrations in June, these events brought the community together. Thank you to everyone who contributed to, supported or attended the events which were, of course, held at short notice.
