### 83. CLERK'S REPORT AND CORRESPONDENCE

83.1 <u>HSBC Branch Closure</u> – A letter had been circulated regarding the closure of the HSBC branch. Cllr. Holmes asked for it to be noted that she is concerned about the lack of facilities for Blandford residents and that the building will be left to decay like the Barclays one currently is. Cllr Carter queried the possibility of having a banking hub. Cllr Quayle said that he is already exploring this option but that the biggest issue is that having a hub may force the other banks to close. He will continue to monitor the situation but has said that if it is possible it can take 2-3 years to set up. The Town Clerk had spoken to Nicci Brown and queried if it could be used as a community resource/hub but unfortunately it is at the end of its lease and therefore HSBC cannot help. Cllr Bray said that the post office offers an excellent service and it is a great place for people to meet which addresses isolation and asks councillors to encourage people to use it. Cllr Osborne said that as its much simpler to bank now there are many other options that can be utilised.

- 83.3 Applications for Tree Works Dorset Council is in the process of working on a new module which allows town and parish councils to choose what tree applications they are notified about. However, until this module is live officers have confirmed that they will continue to notify town and parish councils and ward members where proposals are made to fell trees. If information is required on other tree work applications (where felling is not proposed) then a search will have to be made on the Dorset Council planning site <a href="https://planning.dorsetcouncil.gov.uk/">https://planning.dorsetcouncil.gov.uk/</a>. It is possible to carry out a general search of the parish without an application number by using the 'advanced search' option and entering Blandford Forum under 'Parish'.
