## **Clerk's Report & Correspondence**

<u>The Hive, Kings Road</u> – A letter was sent as requested at the last Planning Committee meeting. An enforcement case was already open and BFTC's comments have been added.

<u>Church Lane pedestrian crossing safety improvements</u> – The Dorset Council plans to make safety improvements to the pedestrian crossing at the southern end of Church Lane. This is part of the works on the footways in Blandford Forum that are being carried out from the 6<sup>th</sup> September 2021 to the 22<sup>nd</sup> of November 2021.

The footway will be built out by just over a metre east on the western side to allow for greater visibility. The footway on the eastern side next to St Peter and St Paul's Church will be narrowed to accommodate for this.

Construction is programmed to start on Monday the 13<sup>th</sup> of September 2021, lasting 2 weeks until Friday the 24<sup>th</sup> of September 2021. It is planned to close the lower 40 metres of Church Lane for the first 5 days of the works only (13<sup>th</sup>-17<sup>th</sup> September), for the kerbs to be moved and replaced, as well as the new carriageway surface to go down.

<u>Road Closure</u> – All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along Church Lane, Blandford Forum from Market Place to a point 40 metres to the north. The Notice is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise the likelihood of danger to highway users. It will come into operation on 13<sup>th</sup> September 2021 between and remain in force for five days, but it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 17<sup>th</sup> September 2021. This Notice will enable Dorset Council to build out the footway on western side and take back the kerb line on the eastern side to maintain road width.

## To consider Nordon s106 contributions for Town Council play area facilities

#### **Background**

The Nordon s106 agreement includes the following contributions for play equipment in Blandford Forum:

- £967.52 per dwelling for Destination Play Facilities (means the improvement of off-site destination play facilities including LEAP, NEAP, MUGA, Skate/Wheeled Play and Outdoor Gym to be provided) x 40 dwellings = £38,700.80
- £128.73 per dwelling towards the maintenance of Destination Play Facilities x 40 dwellings = £5,149.20
- £1,318.80 per dwelling towards the formal outdoor sports pitches = £52,752.00

## Report

At the Planning Committee meeting held on 26th July 2021, Councillors resolved that

The Town Council approves expenditure of £11,310.30 + VAT and selects equipment A to replace the multi-play unit at Larksmead using funds from the Larksmead Play Equipment Standard Asset Replacement Accruals (Expenditure Authority: Localism Act 2011 s1-8).

It was suggested by the Chairman of Council that the expenditure is claimed from the Nordon s106 agreement for Destination Play Facilities and this has been discussed between the Town Clerk and a DC officer.

Councillors should consider if they wish to claim any further money from this development. The maintenance cost for the new tower at Larksmead is estimated to be £2,200 + VAT over the next ten years. That will allow for edge repairs or over skim and minor repairs on the unit. It should also be considered for the potential to claim for new equipment and maintenance costs for Park Road play area as it is in the vicinity of the new estate.

Some of the funds could also be used by the Dorset Council for enhancements to the Trailway.

#### Recommendation

Councillors should consider if officers should approach the Dorset Council to claim s106 contributions for the purchase of the new play equipment tower in Larksmead Play Area, the maintenance cover for the new tower at Larksmead and Park Road play area.
