### Clerk's Report & Correspondence

<u>Blandford+ Neighbourhood Plan</u> – The Dorset Council has had to employ a special counsel to look carefully at the legal challenge. This has taken much longer than anticipated due to the counsel being unfamiliar with the situation, the Neighbourhood Plan documentation being abundant and complex and the Covid-19 crisis. We have been assured that our NP would not be determined by Wyatt's planning application or the determination of the Dorset Local Plan. In the latter, DC has identified the land North East of Blandford Forum as development land with the addition of the Waites piece of land between the proposed Wyatt development and Black Lane. A meeting was held on 6<sup>th</sup> January, but a further meeting needs to be held and therefore we are still waiting for the Decision Statement from DC.
