Cllr L Hitchings proposed a dispensation to all Councillors, excluding Cllr Cross, for voting on the impact the project would have on the precept, but this was not seconded.

MINUTES OF THE CORN EXCHANGE MEETING HELD ON 16th OCTOBER 2023 25.

It was PROPOSED by Cllr Carter, SECONDED by Cllr Lacey-Clarke and AGREED (12 in favour, 2 abstentions) that the Minutes be APPROVED and SIGNED.

26. TO CONFIRM THE APPOINTMENT OF THE CONTRACTOR FROM THE TENDER PROCESS, AND ASSOCIATED EXPENDITURE, AND APPROVE THE LOAN APPLICATION TO THE **PUBLIC WORKS LOAN BOARD**

The paper was noted (see Appendix A).

26. TO CONFIRM THE APPOINTMENT OF THE CONTRACTOR FROM THE TENDER PROCESS, AND ASSOCIATED EXPENDITURE, AND APPROVE THE LOAN APPLICATION TO THE PUBLIC WORKS LOAN BOARD (cont.)

Ross Ingham delivered a presentation to attendees, summarising the journey of the project and the significance of the current position. He spoke about the importance of the improved disabled access and continuing with what we are currently doing but doing it much better.

Cllr L Hitchings asked about the timing of the interest rate on the PWLB and if it needed to be drawn down immediately or could be delayed until the funds are required.

Chairman, Cllr Miéville requested a recorded vote, due to the significance of the decision with this being the first time the Town Council has been in a position to proceed with the project after decades of attempts.

It was PROPOSED by Cllr White, SECONDED by Cllr Lindsay and AGREED unanimously that

The Town Council:

- Appoints Contractor A, subject to the successful completion of a process of value engineering.
- Confirms notification of the appointment on the Contracts Finder website.
- Agrees expenditure authority for the project of £3,461,630 including fees, with the reallocation of the Reserves referred to in Appendix A (Expenditure Authority: General Power of Competence Localism Act 2011 s1-8).
- Approves the PWLB application for a loan of £1,300,000 being submitted with the following wording:

At the full council meeting of the Blandford Forum Town Council Corn Exchange meeting of Monday 12th February 2024, it was resolved unanimously to seek the approval of the Secretary of State for Levelling Up, Housing and Communities to apply for a PWLB loan of £1,300,000 over the borrowing term of 50 years (EIP) for the Grade I Listed Town Hall / Corn Exchange refurbishment project. The annual loan repayments will come to around £100,000 a year. It is not intended to increase the council tax/precept for the purpose of the loan repayments.
