## To approve an application for a loan to the Public Works Loan Board

#### **Background**

At the Town Council Corn Exchange meeting held on 29th November 2021 it was resolved that:

The Town Council agrees to proceed with a loan via the Public Works Loan Board subject to it being the most feasible option when the council is in a position to do so.

#### Report

The project has now progressed to the stage where it requires more detailed financial planning and the authority to apply for an application to the Public Works Loans Board to gain the funding to proceed. This is subject to discussions regarding the increase in costs for the overall project. In addition, it has been the Town Council's aim that the loan repayments should be within the affordability envelope that has previously been discussed.

Due to commercial sensitivity at this stage, the financial information will be discussed in confidential session.

#### **Recommendation**

It is recommended that Councillors approve the application to the Public Works Loan Board for a loan to enable the project to go forward.

## To seek approval to start the contractor procurement process
