Town Clerk's Report & Correspondence

Allotment Relocation – The Town Council solicitor has advised that the Blandford Trusts and Wyatt now wish to proceed to exchange. On completion the Town Council will collect the option fee (£15,000) *plus* VAT and the contribution to the professional costs up to £25,000 for solicitors and £17,500 of land agent fees. The RFO has therefore sent the invoice for this.

Data Protection Toolkit Service – The RFO recently undertook training, with a specialist company that works with the DAPTC, for the new Assertion 10 rules for the audit process that are being introduced. As a result, the Town Council was offered a £100 discount from £695+VAT for 12 months to £595+VAT, which has been accepted, and the service includes:

- Online hub with guided learning journey for data protection and FOI
- Assertion 10 readiness support
- Data protection and FOI deep-dive best practice masterclasses for senior staff
- Unlimited, regular refresher training courses on Zoom for all council staff
- Unlimited, regular refresher training courses on Zoom for all councillors
- 2 hours of 1-2-1 Darren time and bespoke support over the 12 months
- No obligation to renew beyond 12 months

To retrospectively approve expenditure for replacement laptops and consider usage for the redundant machines

The Market Manager's laptop was updated and approved during the 2024-25 financial year. The laptops for the RFO, Town Clerk and Operations Manager have recently been replaced during this financial year. They are the HP Notebook 15.6" i5, 16GB RAM, 512SSD, Win 11 Pro, 3 year warranty.

To date, two members of staff have asked if they can purchase the old machines from the Town Council and the Town Clerk has advised that the Councillors will be asked for their views.

One laptop is required for the AV booth so it can be used by the council for events/meetings but there is no requirement for the other machines.

Recommendation

Councillors are asked to retrospectively approve expenditure for the three laptops purchased during this financial year at £549.89 each and to consider selling old (wiped) machines to staff.
