The above planning application was heard at the Planning Committee meeting on 13<sup>th</sup> October 2025, and the following resolution was made-

*The Town Council objects to the proposal on the basis on insufficient parking and are saddened that they haven't used our design code but do recognise that it is in keeping with the rest of the development. Blandford + NP policies B10, Design Code: CA1, Built Form Codes 1,2,3,4,6,7,8 & 10 -20 all apply.*

The applicant since increased the parking provision and Dorset Council (DC) Highways subsequently removed their same objection.

DC's Planning department therefore emailed Blandford Forum Town Council to ask if, in light of the increased parking provision and removal of the Highways objection, it would consider changing its position.

Due to Councillors being asked if there was any change and no replies being received the Committee Clerk responded to DC, who then asked for it to be reconsidered at a meeting. Otherwise it will need to be referred to DC's Planning Committee.
