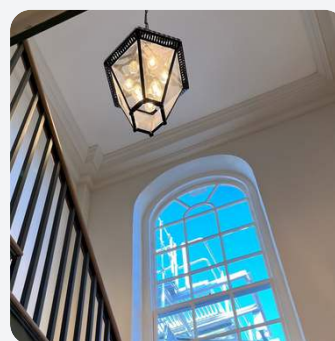

Corn Exchange



The Corn Exchange is our largest venue and holds a maximum capacity of 200 people. It boasts a stunning decor for your event, with an audio/visual booth, acoustic panelling, and spacious stage.

Council Chamber

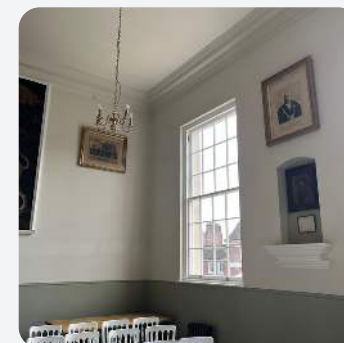


The Council Chamber is upstairs and is accessed by the lift or staircase. It has a large oak table and holds a maximum of 15 people. It is the ideal place for the Registrar to discretely meet with the bride or groom prior to the ceremony.

Town Hall



The Town Hall is upstairs overlooking the Market Place, and can be accessed via a lift or a beautiful staircase. It holds a maximum of 50 people, and separate seating is provided for this room.
