Cllr Quayle explained that he has taken this complaint to Highways in the past, he is meeting with the Highways Officer later this week and will discuss these concerns. Cllr H Miéville met with Dorset Police last week, they explained they are seeing a reduction in anti-social behaviour, Cllr Miéville will write up a report and circulate it to councillors.

65. CLERK'S REPORT AND CORRESPONDENCE

B+ Monitoring Group Update – A letter was sent to Simon Hoare MP on 23rd February 2026 on behalf of the Blandford+ Neighbourhood Plan Monitoring Group to seek his support to ensure that **all** S106 collected for primary health care in the Blandford+ areas (and surrounding villages using the town as their hub) is ring-fenced for primary health provision in the Blandford area.

Comedy Night – The comedy night went well and £879.50 was taken on the bar.

Tile Sponsorship Scheme – The tile sponsorship scheme has now closed. It went very well and just under £3,500 was received from donations. The Town Clerk is now compiling a book of the sponsors including a history of the tiles and photos throughout the works.

Recycling – The Operations Manager has placed an order with Dorset Council for monthly glass and recycling collections totalling a combined cost of £201.37. This is due to the amount of glass and cans we are using at Corn Exchange events. Not wanting to hold bins in the Shambles, arrangements have been made for the bins to be located at Woodhouse Gardens.
